

Recycling

Recycling is basically taking something old and making it into something new. The process of recycling requires a waste product to be returned to where it is remade either the same product or something different. For example factories make new plastic items such as buckets from discarded plastic items.

Did you know?

The city produces around 4,300 tons of waste per day. People in Dar es Salaam throw away 6 tons, 700 elephants per day of trash!!! But only 40% of Waste goes to a dump site, while the rest goes to Rivers and the Ocean. Forests, Rains wash the trash into drains which then flow into the sea and increase the risk of mosquito borne (Malaria) diseases including typhoid and cholera. Burning trash releases toxic chemicals into the air including mercury and arsenic which are all dangerous.

How long do each of these types of waste take to break down?

- Paper = **2 Months.**
- Aluminium can = **80 years.**
- Plastic bottle = **500 years** (although it never decomposes, it just breaks down)
- Glass bottle = **thousands of years.**

Nylon

Clear and semi-clear plastic wrapping used for packaging



Plastic bottles

Soda, water, shampoo, sauce, and other plastic bottle.

(leave cap and label on)



Cans & Tin

Should be washed out and empty

Newspaper, coloured or dirty paper



Cardboard that is very dirty or wet.

Dirty pizza boxes, oily brown bags, Tetra pack, juice or milk



Anything that isn't a bottle.

Window glass, mirror glass etc.



Nylon

Any other coloured plastic bags



Any other plastic wrap, plastic containers, yogurt containers



Tin foil, aerosol cans, rusted or dirty tin/ cans
